### About the organisation

STOCKHOLM! project is a Swedish non-profit organisation working at the intersection of public space, learning, and international cultural cooperation. The organisation develops participatory and educational approaches that use public space as a shared environment for learning, reflection, and encounter.

STOCKHOLM! project was founded as a sister organisation of PRAHO! project (CZ). While sharing values, methodology and long-term vision, STOCKHOLM! project operates as an independent organisation, adapted to the Swedish cultural, institutional and funding context.

### Activities and focus

The organisation's work is primarily process-based and education-oriented. Artistic tools and spatial interventions are used as means to support learning-by-doing, participation and dialogue, rather than as ends in themselves.

In its current phase, STOCKHOLM! project focuses on:

- preparation and development of project concepts,
- grant writing and international cooperation,



- building organisational infrastructure and local partnerships,
- creating conditions for long-term, sustainable activity.

Projects are implemented only once appropriate funding has been secured.

## Current status

STOCKHOLM! project is in an active start-up phase. The organisation has:

- established basic working infrastructure (physical and digital),
- welcomed its first interns,
- initiated local and international partnerships,
- begun systematic work with Swedish, Nordic and European funding programmes.

The organisation is led by Annamarie Čermáková, based in Stockholm, with strategic support from Veronika Matějková.

## Financial principles

STOCKHOLM! project operates with a clear principle of financial responsibility and transparency. Activities are funded through grants and partnerships, and the organisation prioritises long-term sustainability over short-term output.

The organisation maintains its own financial and accounting structure and cooperates with PRAHO! project only within clearly defined project or partnership frameworks.

## Cooperation and international dimension

STOCKHOLM! project actively develops cooperation within Sweden, the Nordic region and Europe. International collaboration is understood as a core value and a key tool for learning, exchange of know-how and long-term impact.

The relationship with PRAHO! project is based on trust, transparency and mutual benefit, allowing both organisations to strengthen their positions in their respective contexts.

## Outlook

In the coming period, STOCKHOLM! project will continue to:

- strengthen its position within the Swedish and Nordic cultural landscape,
- develop international partnerships and European cooperation,
- stabilise its organisational and financial capacities,
- build a sustainable framework for future educational and participatory activities.
